## 1 INTRODUCTION

- 1.1.1 The Standard¹ does not specifically exclude remanufactured/reconditioned engines, as these parts were not envisaged to be included within its scope. However, there have been requests from a few vehicle recyclers to include remanufactured/reconditioned parts.
- 1.1.2 The remanufacture/reconditioning of an engine, either by the recycler or a third party, has potential to:
  - Disrupt the audit trail and traceability of the engine from its donor vehicle;
  - Weaken the provenance of the part; and
  - Result in poor quality workmanship that may impair the engine's quality and/or performance.

Moreover, it opens up the possibility of illegally sourced parts being used on bona fide engines.

1.1.3 On the 17 January 2022, the VRAC Technical Advisory Committee reviewed whether remanufactured/reconditioned engines/gearboxes could be included within the standard. this policy statement sets out VRAC's position in this matter.

## 2 POLICY CLARIFICATION

- 2.1.1 The remanufacture and/or reconditioning of an engine and/or gearbox, either by a vehicle recycler or a third-party falls, outside of the scope of the standard.
- 2.1.2 This policy shall remain in force until the Standard is formally reviewed and updated, when it shall no longer be applicable.
